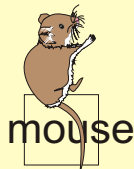
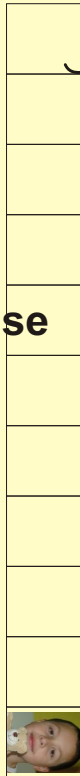


The cat-and-mouse game
